

Block of the Month -- for January Of 2008

Appliqué this cute little fellow (with any method you want) onto a 6 1/2" square of fabric. The snowman can be any "snow" color -- white or a light neutral -- perhaps you have a special print that would look good. Use a background fabric that will contrast with your snowman -- maybe light blue to indicate a daytime winter sky. You may simplify and/or embellish him in any way you choose. The eyes, nose, mouth and pipe could be buttons or embroidery stitches like French knots (or you could omit the pipe if your snowman is "non-smoking"). How about a piece of ribbon tacked down for his scarf?

We were not very successful at getting participation at the hands-on meeting in December, so the snowman is re-appearing in January. I imagine there will still be snow!! I did receive two very cute appliquéd snowmen entries in December and they will be part of the drawing in January. Enjoy!
